- Hancock County Road Department has to install culvert pipes on Boone Road, Gilbert Road, and Smith Road. Culverts have been ordered and delivered to make repairs.

- Linton Community paved ditches and culverts have been cleared and cleaned out by Barksdale Contracting and Supply (7-10-19)
- Island Creek Drive and Lake Sinclair Drive are being inspected in their entirety to locate all culverts and drain pipes to ensure proper drainage and regular maintenance.
  - Data is being collected so that all culverts are located, and a detailed maintenance file is being kept.
  - This process is in the beginning stages and will be valuable in moving forward with county road repairs in the future.
- Hancock County Road Consultants are also rating county roads and compiling data so that we have a detailed plan and prioritized list for resurfacing and paving.
  - The process is underway and will take some time, but I will keep you all posted as this process progresses.
- The 2019 LMIG Resurfacing Project is scheduled to begin by the end of July 2019
- Patching on various county roads is scheduled to begin in August 2019 and will be performed by Southern Asphalt and Hancock County Road Department.
