- Hancock County Offices will resume business with continued limited access until further notice.
- Each Constitutional Office has measures in place to prevent COVID -19 contaminations and contact those offices for information or to schedule appointments
- Hancock County has created a public message number **706-444-6535** which can be called at any time by anyone to receive updates. The message will be updated as deemed necessary.

The Governor has only completely shut-down a few specific businesses, including gyms, fitness centers, bowling alleys, theaters, live performance venues, operator of amusements rides, body art studios, beauty shops, beauty salons, barber shops, cosmetology schools, estheticians, massage therapy, and bars. Restaurants and social clubs shall cease dine-in services, but may continue takeout, curbside pick-up, and delivery, with the exception that hospitals, healthcare facilities, and nursing homes may continue in-room dining.

For all remaining businesses, the order creates two categories, **Critical Infrastructure** and **Non-Critical Infrastructure**. Both types are allowed to continue, but they are certain restrictions on how each is to operate. Essentially, both types can continue, but certain measures must be taken by the businesses.

For sheltered citizens, visitors to one’s home are only allowed for visitors, as long as social distancing measures are maintained:

- i. Providing medical services;
- ii. Providing support for the person to conduct activities of daily living or instrumental activities of daily living;
- iii. Providing necessary supplies and groceries; or
- iv. For end-of-life circumstances for the visited.
