 “The perimeter of the entire Property shall be fenced with (1) a 10’ high fence (which may be chain link) along the “front” of the Property (along the road side and public access portions of the property), to be installed on or before April 30, 2019, and (2) the remainder of the Property perimeter shall be fenced with a minimum 4’ tall fence to be completed on or before August 30, 2019.”
