- Staff Present: County Attorney Adam Nelson and Assistant Clerk Jamarus Walls.

Adoption of Agenda:

- A motion was proposed by Comm. Cooper to adopt the agenda (with the necessary correction to page 2 date correction) and the motion was seconded by Comm. Reid. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion.

Adoption of Minutes RE: August 25, 2021, Regular Meeting and September 10, 2021, Mill Rate Hearing and Adoption:

- A motion was proposed by Comm. Clayton to adopt the above referenced minutes and the motion was seconded by Comm. Reid. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion.

Administration:

- Hancock County Transit RE: Adoption of Title VI Plan
  - After discussion, a motion was proposed by Comm. Cooper to approve the Hancock County Transit Title VI Plan (which is necessary to inform the public and recipients of reviewing processes to comply with the Georgia Department of Transportation Title VI of the Civil Rights Act) and the motion was seconded by Comm. Reid. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion. (SEE ATTACHED)

- Hancock County Convenience Center Updates –
  - Hunts Chapel Convenience Center Lease Agreement RE: Approval  
After discussion, a motion was proposed by Comm. Reid to approve the lease agreement for the Hunts Chapel Convenience Center Site with Mr. Kevin Braswell and the motion was seconded by Comm. Clayton. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion. (SEE ATTACHED)
  - County Clerk Foster provided an update on the Fairmont Road Site and the Hunts Chapel Site.
  - Finishing touches are delayed on the Fairmont Road Site and new dumpsters are on the schedule to be delivered and organized to make it easier for citizens to dispose of household waste along with other measures to provide convenient services.
  - Hunts Chapel site is in the process of being graded/graveled, culverts installed, and new dumpsters placed in a single convenient area.
  
- Overview Update:
  - Chairman Hudson provided an update on the overview home repairs and energy assistance program. There are 12 home awaiting bids as of now and more detailed information will be available to provide at the next meeting.
  
- Discussion – Approval RE: Reconstitution of Mask Ordinance
  - After discussion and guidance by Attorney Nelson, a motion was proposed by Comm. Reid to approve the Mask Ordinance for 30 days and move forward in 30-day increments. The motion was seconded by Comm. Clayton and carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion. (SEE ATTACHED)
  
- Discussion RE: Georgia Forestry Building – MIA Food Bank
  - After discussion, Commissioners tabled for further discussion and proposed meeting with Mr. Timothy Maddox.
