- Discussion RE: Reapportionment District Maps:
 - Commissioners discussed reapportionment mapping and local legislation mapping presented by Sen. David Lucas. No final decision was made. (SEE ATTACHED)
- Approval RE: Language Access Plan 2021 – 2026 (LAP) for 2021 CDBG & 2022 CDBG CV Grants:
 - After discussion, a motion was proposed by Comm. Clayton to approve the Language Access Plan (LAP) 2021 – 2026 and the motion was seconded by Comm. Hill. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion. LAPs are required by Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) in conjunction with Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) (SEE ATTACHED)
- Discussion RE: Mayfield Water & Sewer System:
 - Commissioners discussed a proposal from Josh Waites referencing the county accepting the Mayfield Community water and sewer system in conjunction with a third-party development. No final decision was made, and County Attorney Nelson will research the matter further.
- Discussion RE: Setback Distances at Lake (Zoning)
 - Commissioners discussed setback requirements at the lake area and no final decision was made referencing changing the 75ft requirement. County Attorney Nelson is going further research the matter and coordinate with Planning and Zoning.
- Appointment RE: Community Service Board (Helen G. Hudson)
 - After discussion, a motion was proposed by Comm. Cooper to appoint Chairman Hudson to the Community Service Board replacing Comm. Reid, and the motion was seconded by Comm. Hill. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion.
- Discussion RE: Summer Camp and Community and Schools Funding:
 - After discussion, commissioners agreed to move forward with summer camp in conjunction with funding from Communities in Schools and Mrs. Regina Butts. There will be 3 camps and guidelines outlined for each camp. (SEE ATTACHED)

- Update RE: Transportation Initiative Act (TIA) / T-SPLOST Projects
 - Sparta Hancock County Truck Route was discussed and the let date for bidding is scheduled for July 2022.
 - Lake Crest Extension is in band 3 and engineers are being solicited to draft plans.
 - Friendship Nebo resurfacing project is in Band 1 and Gilbert Road widening and paving project is in Band 2.
 - Commissioners also discussed other financial obligations in conjunction with the 2021 CDBG Recreation Rehabilitation and 2022 CDBG CV Health Department Covid Renovations.
- CSRA Unified Development Authority (UDA) RE: Reappointment of Allen Haywood and Latunya Goodwin
 - After discussion, a motion was proposed by Comm. Cooper to reappointment Mr. Haywood and Mrs. Goodwin to the CSRA UDA and the motion was seconded by Comm. Hill. The motion was carried with all the commissioners present voting in favor of the motion.
