Notice is hereby given that The Hancock County Board of Commissioners will let a contract to a single, responsible, qualified, general contractor, bidder by sealed bids submitted to the office of the Hancock County Commission Office, 12630 Broad Street, Sparta, Georgia 31087, **no later than 1:00 p.m., local time FRIDAY OCTOBER 21ST 2022,** for the renovations to the Hancock County Health Department as outlined in the Construction Documents and Project Manual.

Any bids to be mailed should be addressed to the above address and marked as “Hancock County Health Department Renovation”. Bid Documents can be obtained online by sending an email request to info@carterwatkins.com Additionally, drawings will be on-file with Construct Connect; FW Dodge; and AGC Builder’s Exchange. No copies will be printed or mailed. Bidders are responsible for accessing PDF files online and having prints made. Additionally, all Bidders are responsible to check the Architect’s FTP Site periodically for any Addenda that have been issued.

A pre-bid Conference shall be conducted on TUESDAY OCTOBER 4th at 1:00 p.m. at the Health Department located at 516 Boland Street Sparta, Georgia. Attendance is not mandatory. The Contractor shall achieve Substantial Completion within 270 days from the date of Commencement.

The project is funded, in part, by a Community Development Block Grant. Bidders must comply with all Department of Community Affairs requirements, wage rates, etc. and must not be on the debarred list. Section 3 employment procedures must be followed as well. Refer to the CDBG Clauses in the project manual. Bidders are to provide Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act Affidavit at the time of bid proposal as well as a Bid Bond. Omission of any of these completed forms can make the bidder non-responsive.

Both a Performance Bond in an amount equal to 100% of the Contract Price and a Payment Bond will be required in an amount equal to 110% of the Contract Price will be required. Proof of General Liability Insurance and Workman’s Compensation Insurance will be required with Hancock County listed as an additional insured. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Funds in the amount of 5% of the Bid Amount. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities or irregularities and to award the bid based on the best interests of Hancock County.
