Your community needs you! By staffing a polling location, you will:

- Earn \$17.60 hr. as a Manager for working on Election Day.
- Assistant managers earn \$13.20hr.
- Clerks can earn \$11.00 hr.

See our great democracy in action, firsthand, and enjoy the feeling that comes with contributing to your local community, your state, and your country.

Be a part of your democracy – become a Poll Worker! Poll Workers are trained to aid voters on Election Day, guide them through the voting process, and answer any questions voters have. They are a vital part of every election!

Residents ages 16 and up, including college and High School students, are encouraged to apply.

- You must attend training provided by the Board of Elections Supervisor
- All Poll Workers must attend training classes at least once every two years.
- When new Laws are introduced, mandatory training may be required for all.
- New Poll Worker classes are held at the Youth Opportunity Center located at 12560 Augusta Hwy E. Sparta Ga.
- Training Classes consist of watching a poll worker video provided by the Secretary
 of State and hands-on training on the election equipment. Training usually lasts at
 least 3 to 4 hours. They are held 2 3 weeks prior to the Primary and General
 Elections.
- You must sign an acknowledgement agreement that you will work election day in order to get paid for training-\$50

You are required to be at your polling station by 6am or whatever time is specified by your polling manager on the morning of the election. Polls open at 7am and close at 7pm.
